Ever wonder about the larger context in which our 3rd-world Mission and Services contributions operate? Here are three books I can lend you or you can get at the Pincourt or your own library. All readable by any of us. All as fascinating as any novel.

1- 28 Stephanie Nolen

Twenty-eight stories, representative of the 28 million Africans living with HIV-AIDS. I put off reading it for fear it would depress - it uplifted and informed me on the overall political context, the good and bad Bill Clinton,

the value of aid, and more. Episodic - reads like 28 short stories.

2- The Shock Doctrine Klein

Montreal-born Naomi Klein builds a strong case against careless and willful efforts of world bodies like the World Trade Organization and U.S. business and government to profit from international crises from the failure of the USSR and South Africa under Apartheid to tsunamis - ready to turn shock into profit. Riveting!

3- The End of Poverty Sachs

Jeffrey Sachs seems to have seen the light. Klein viciously attacks him and his mentor Milton Friedman's work in privatizing national assets. The book is an about-face : a how-to book on wealth sharing. Incredibly readable!
